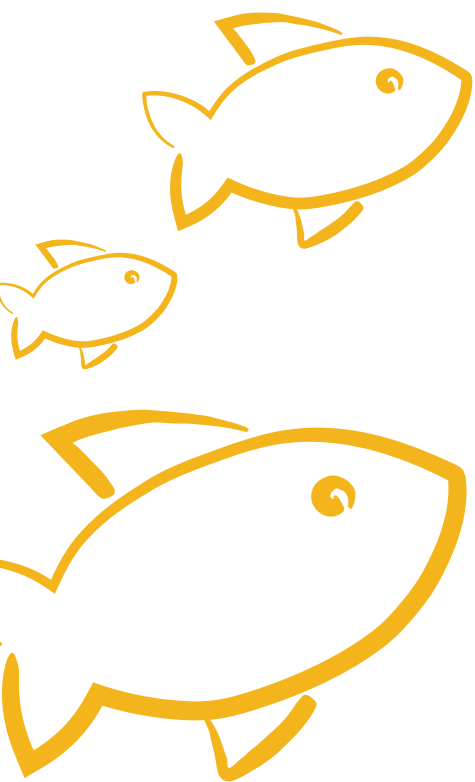


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Welcome to Antigua!

Get ready to enjoy the sunshine on one of the most beautiful islands in the world, because *Sandals Grande Antigua* is located on Dickenson Bay Beach - rated one of the best beaches in all of the Caribbean!



West Coast Guests Saturday, January 7

West Coast guests arrive today. Once you arrive at Antigua's VC Bird International Airport, go through immigration, pick up your luggage and go through customs. Proceed to the Sandals Representatives holding Kyocera signage to guide you to your transportation to the beautiful *Sandals Grande Antigua* resort. After checking in at the Club Sandals Lounge, the rest of the day and evening are yours to explore the resort! All drinks, snacks, meals, hotel entertainment and non-motorized water sports are included. Enjoy the day!

DAY 1 Sunday, January 8

Kyocera Masters Club trip winners arrive at Antigua's VC Bird International Airport. Your Antigua Journeymasters representatives will be holding a Kyocera Masters Club Antigua sign waiting to welcome you and transport you to the celebrated *Sandals Grande Antigua* resort just about 7 miles away.

This AAA Four Diamond award-winner, *Sandals Grande Antigua* is a luxurious adults-only resort located on the sparkling Dickenson Bay Beach. The resort has 6 pools, 7 gourmet á la carte restaurants, 6 bars (including 2 swim-up bars), a full-service spa, fitness center and more. *Sandals Grande Antigua*



is an All-Inclusive resort, which means all meals, snacks and drinks, land and non-motorized water sports, tips and taxes are all included. Club Level Room Service is available from 7:00AM to 10:00PM. These breakfast options are available today and every day of your stay, so we'll mention it just this one time. The rest of the morning is yours to explore this beautiful resort and island! Visit the Kyocera Masters Club Hospitality Desk located in the lobby on the third floor of the Mediterranean Village for suggestions and reservations.

Lunch at leisure

Corral* serves Southwestern cuisine 6:30 to 9:30PM, and expert Sushi chefs prepare fresh and delectable sushi at the *Soy Sushi Bar* from 5:30 to 9:00PM.

Kyocera Masters Club Antigua Answer Book

What will the weather be like?

Answer: Sun, sun, and more sun! During the month of January, the average daily high is 83°, the low 72°. Antigua averages about 2 inches of rain for the month, so we may have a few tropical showers - hopefully quickly here and quickly gone! Sparkling pools and beautiful beaches here we come!

What should I pack for clothes?

Answer: Casual sport clothes during the day. Bring things you feel comfortable walking in or playing in. Our first Masters Club gathering is on the beach - so shorts, dresses, just about anything goes. Our final evening is a special night, so you may want to be a bit dressier. It starts with a cocktail party outdoors by the *Reflection Pool*, then we move inside to the *Admiral Lord Nelson's Ballroom* for a gala gourmet three course dinner, with awards and a photographer. See **What is the dress code for dinner?** on the following page.

A worthwhile tip: while it may be warm outside, all indoor spots will be air-conditioned to about 60°; at least it always seems like 60°. When you're sitting still you can get pretty chilled. It's a good idea to bring a shoulder wrap, light sweater or a jacket.



What is the dress code for dinner?

Answer: Most of the restaurants at *Sandals Grande Antigua* list their dress codes as **Resort Casual** with the exception of *Eleanor's*, which has a **Resort Evening** dress code for dinner. Since our final evening is an awards night with a photographer, we recommend you go a little dressier with **Resort Evening**, if you wish.

Resort Casual: For men, shorts or jeans, T-shirts or polo shirts. Ladies, shorts, jeans, sundresses. Swimwear must be covered. Shirts and footwear required.

Resort Evening: Dress pants or jeans for men, long or short sleeve dress shirts (with or without collar), no sleeveless shirts. Dress shoes or sandals. Ladies, your best resort wear, chic/tropical attire...the choice is yours. No shorts, T-shirts, sleeveless shirts, sneakers, flip flops, slippers or hats.

What are the passport requirements?

Important Answer: A valid (not expired) passport is required for all U.S. Citizens. It is required that your passport have an expiration date of a minimum of 6 months after your return date (July 13, 2023).

What can I expect upon arrival in Antigua?

Important Answer: Upon arrival at VC Bird International Airport, present your passport and clear Antiguan immigration, then proceed to the baggage claim area and pick up your bags. Next, clear Customs and a Sandals representative will guide you toward your transportation to the hotel, just about a 15 minute drive away!



What if I am not a U.S. Citizen?

Answer: Citizens of other countries and U.S. residents with foreign passports may need additional documentation (such as a permanent resident card, or a visa) for entry along with a passport. Contact your country's Embassy or Consulate for information about the requirements specific to your situation.

Do I receive airline tickets?

Answer: Your airline itinerary/e-ticket receipt is included in this Winner's Mailing.

How much luggage may I bring?

Answer: There is a charge for checked bags the airlines. Here is the per person allowance as of December 2022, subject to change:

American Airlines

- ✳ First Bag \$30 ✳ Second Bag \$40
- ✳ Additional bags \$200+ each

JetBlue Airways

- ✳ First Bag \$35 ✳ Second Bag \$45
- ✳ Additional bags \$150+ each

The total combined dimensions (length + width + height) can't exceed 62 inches per bag and must not weigh over 50 pounds. Fees for oversize or overweight bags can be as high as \$200, depending on the airline. You are allowed one carry-on bag with total combined dimensions not exceeding 45 inches and 40 pounds. Plus one personal item such as a purse or laptop.



Don't forget the 3-1-1 Rule for carry-ons:

3.4 ounce (100 ml) bottle or less (by volume); 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag; 1 bag per passenger placed in screening bin. If in doubt, put your liquids in checked luggage.

What about luggage tags?

Answer: Two special Kyocera Masters Club luggage tags for each guest are included in this mailing. Please be certain to put one on every piece of luggage you check. If the airline does "misplace" (we never say "lose" a bag), it's immeasurably easier to locate the misplaced luggage if there are Kyocera bag tags attached.

What should I see on my baggage receipt?

Answer: Check your luggage: The airline baggage receipt should have ANU (that's VC Bird International Airport in airline language) on the top line as final destination for your baggage. Keep the receipt in a safe place, they may ask for it when claiming your bag.

When should I be at the airport?

Important Answer: TSA suggests arriving at least 2-3 hours prior to your scheduled flight time. Security lines are expected to be longer due to TSA delays. Three hours may be too early if your flight has an early morning departure. If you are unsure, please call your airline and ask what time the ticket counter opens in your departure city. You'll need to



be at your departure gate 45 minutes prior to departure. Note: this rule applies now more than ever. Security has been tightened, so please be patient.

Will I earn Frequent Flyer points on my flight?

Answer: Yes, please call or email us with your frequent flyer number. If you would like to join, call or go online:

What about prescription medicines?

Answer: Pack them in your carry-on bag. Luggage does occasionally get misplaced, usually temporarily, but sometimes temporarily is too long to go without your prescription medicines.

What is the time difference?

Answer: Currently, Antigua is one hour ahead of Eastern Time (New York), two hours ahead of Central Time (Chicago), three hours ahead of Mountain Time (Denver), and four hours ahead of Pacific Time (San Francisco).

Antigua does not observe Daylight Savings Time.

What's the electricity at Sandals?

Answer: The electrical supply at the *Sandals Grande Antigua* is 110 volts/60 cycles standard, so no adapter is necessary.



Can I use my cell phone? What about Wi-Fi?

Answer: For cell phone use, please contact your cell phone provider to see if your plan includes international service. Most public areas of *Sandals Grande Antigua* and all of the rooms have Wi-Fi coverage for your convenience and pleasure. Instant access to the internet may be obtained simply by connecting to the network.

What is the currency in Antigua?

Answer: Currency in Antigua is the Eastern Caribbean Dollar, although most merchants accept the U.S. Dollar for payment. Currency exchange is available at the hotel's front desk. Most establishments also accept major credit cards.

Can I use my credit cards?

Answer: Yes. While at Sandals, although everything is included, you may also want to enjoy optional on-site and off-site experiences, spa treatments, or purchase items from the gift shop. *Sandals Grande Antigua* accepts major credit cards.

We suggest you contact your bank or credit card company and let them know about your travel plans. Most banks and credit card companies keep track of spending patterns and may interpret an unexpected overseas purchase as credit card fraud.



What is my room like at Sandals Grande Antigua?

Answer: All Masters Club Winners stay in spectacular Club Level Suites. They are spacious and luxurious, each with a private terrace or balcony! Each room is furnished with a king bed, cozy sitting area, and flat screen TV. A mini-bar is included in your suite, refreshed daily with select liquors. Your mini-fridge is stocked daily with water, beer, juices, & sodas. Your bathroom is a large spa-inspired space with Red Lane® Spa amenities.

Is there a hair dryer in my room?

Answer: Yes there is; a real portable one on your vanity, not the fake kind that hangs on the wall.

Are the contents of the mini-fridge and bar free?

Answer: Yes. Your mini-fridge will be replenished daily with beer, juice, soft drinks, and bottled water. Your suite also includes a variety of select spirits stocked daily.

What else is included on my trip?

Answer: The beautiful *Sandals Grande Antigua* is an All-Inclusive Resort. All meals and snacks, unlimited top shelf spirits, wine by the glass, natural fruit juices and soft drinks are included. Room service is available for your convenience from 7:00AM-10:00PM. Drinks by the pool, daily maid service, day-time activities, live nightly entertainment, all taxes and gratuities, and in-room Wi-Fi are



also included. Our Club Level rooms include 24-hour access to *Club Sandals Lounge* and concierge service between 8:00AM -10:00PM to assist you with just about anything. Where is the Hospitality Desk located?

Answer: The Kyocera Masters Club Hospitality Desk will be located in the Mediterranean Village main lobby on the third floor. Please come by and say hello! We'll be there each day from 8:00AM to 6:00PM.

What about tipping?

Answer: All gratuities to service people for your group trip are included.

How do I check-out of Sandals Grande Antigua?

Answer: The morning of your departure, the hotel will slide your incidental bill under your door. Review your charges, then head down to the *Club Sandals Lounge* to check-out.
